About TAFPC

TAFPC, a PC(USA) congregation, was founded in 1980 by a group of Taiwanese immigrants who began meeting for weekly Bible study and fellowship in central New Jersey. Today, TAFPC holds two concurrent worship services on Sundays at 11:00 AM — one for the Taiwanese Ministry (TM) and one for the English Ministry (EM) — in Hillsborough, NJ.

The English Ministry is a multicultural community that spans all ages, from babies in the nursery to seniors. EM worships in English and leans toward a contemporary style, seeking to nurture faith, deepen relationships, and serve the wider community.

The Role

EM is seeking a balanced, strategic, and people-oriented leader to guide ongoing internal ministries and outreach initiatives. This part-time director will lead and oversee the ministry's fellowship programs, nurture the spiritual growth of members and young families, and collaborate with a small team of elected elders, deacons, and lay leaders of EM. The ideal candidate brings strong interpersonal and emotional wisdom, along with an entrepreneurial spirit to help lead positive change.

Responsibilities

- Help facilitate discussions on vision and leadership for TAFPC's English Ministry
- Attend weekly Sunday EM worship and preach twice a month (for adult worship, children's school, or 11teen)
- Maintain active, positive communication within the congregation and the broader community
- Oversee and support all EM groups (adult, young adult, 11teen, and children's) in their spiritual and fellowship needs
- Provide pastoral care and spiritual guidance to EM members

Qualifications

- Ordained (or candidate for ordination) in one of the following: PC(USA), PCT (Presbyterian Church in Taiwan), Reformed Church in America, Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, or United Church of Christ
- Demonstrated ability to initiate and lead new programs that foster positive change (e.g., service projects, community partnerships, outreach initiatives)
- Strong communication skills
- Strategic and future-oriented leadership style
- Successful completion of a background check required
